

The Columbus Chapter ASIS "American Society for Industrial Security" Scholarship Application 2017

Open to:

1. Students who are interested in a career in the private security, law enforcement, or criminal justice professions.
2. A minimum grade point average of 3.0 (4.0 scale) is required of all applicants.
3. Applicants may be part-time or fulltime students, who have completed their freshman year, at an accredited college or university within the Columbus Chapter, ASIS, boundaries. (See list of schools below)
4. Applicants must be accepted and enrolled in classes in the school term immediately following the receipt of an award.
5. Applicants who have received Columbus Chapter awards, or awards from other ASIS chapters, are eligible to reapply each year. Scholarship awards are deposited to the student's credit at the school where enrolled.

Student Requirements:

1. Complete and application and submit by the deadline.
2. Furnish an official transcript and a faculty member letter of recommendation to the Columbus Chapter's Scholarship Committee.
3. Deliver all requested documents to the ASIS Scholarship Committee, Att. Tom Ingstrum at P.O. Box 1265, Hilliard, OH 43026 on or before the deadline of May 15th, 2017.
